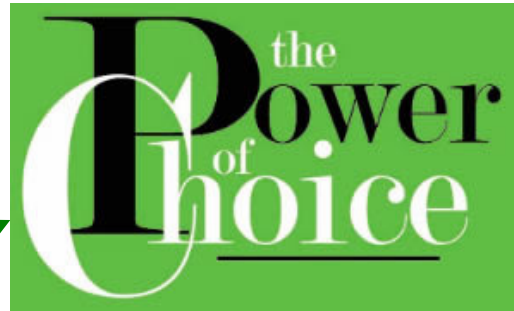

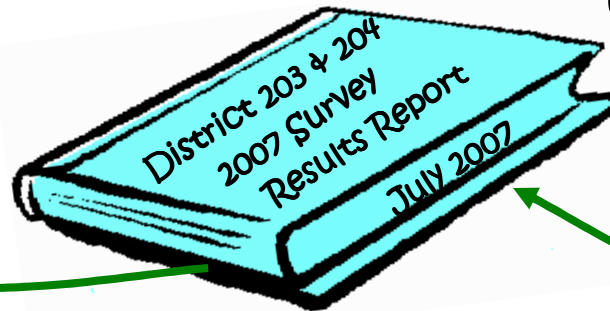

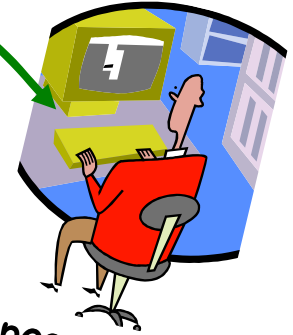


More I Teams (Laffy taffys) for 2007-08

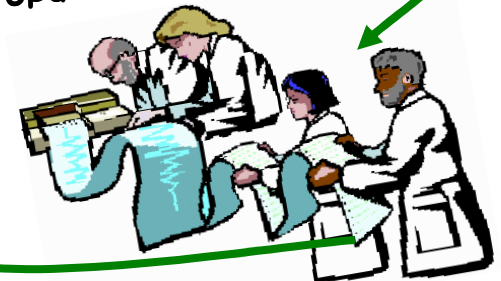
New posters for 2007-08
